Assateague State Park

Maryland's only ocean park is located on Assateague Island, a barrier island bordered on the east by the Atlantic Ocean and on the west by Sinepuxent Bay. Two miles of ocean beaches offer swimming, beachcombing, sunbathing, surfing and fishing. The island's bayside offers canoeing to secluded coves. The marsh areas have a variety of wildlife, including deer and feral horses. Assateague was selected by National Geographic Travel magazine in 1994 as one of the 10 best state parks in the United States.

Features

- Bike trail, boat launch, nature programs, camp sites, camp store, dumping station, food & beverage, fishing, swimming, nature center.
- Swimming Guarded swimming area available from Memorial Day to Labor Day, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.
- Fishing Fishing is available in the boat launch area or from the ocean beach.
- Pets No pets are permitted in the park.
- Boating Launch facilities are on the mainland park acreage.



- Camping 350 sites are available for camping, with a fire ring and picnic table at each campsite, limited electric hook-ups available. Click here for camping season beginning and ending dates, and camping and shelter service charges.

Youth Group Camping

The state park has two areas set aside for youth group camping. These areas are open April 30th to November 1st. Reservations are required. Requests will be honored by the order in which they are received by mail. There is no guarantee. Please contact the park for an application. Incomplete applications will be returned. Confirmations will be mailed.

A \$10.00 reservation service charge must accompany the application. Checks or money orders are payable to *MD DNR-Assateague*. The youth group camping service charge is \$2.00 per person per night, unless you possess a valid Maryland Youth Group Pass. There is no charge if you have a valid Maryland Youth Group Pass. We will be glad to provide you with a youth group pass application if desired.

Each area will accommodate a maximum of 75 persons. The number of adults may not exceed one adult per five youth. Each area has nine picnic tables and five fire rings. Open fires are not permitted. There is an outside rinse platform located adjacent to the camping area. Restroom and showers are available in the day-use bathhouse. Wheeled units or vehicles are not permitted on the site or in the sand. Wheeled units are required to obtain their own site. The youth area beach is not guarded. Please keep everyone off the dunes. Check-in must be before 10 PM. Checkout must be before 11 AM on your day of departure.

The Youth Group Camping Area has been relocated to the northern area of the state park.

Assateague State Park is fully accessible to the disabled. Special campsites, beach wheelchair, fishing pier, and food concessions are all designed for easy access.
